- 💇 Idea 1

Deliver Eco-friendly Community Murals & Street Art

Use street art to beautify neglected areas, with eco-friendly, non-toxic paints to avoid harming the environment. Use themes that will raise awareness of environmental issues, like pollution or protecting local wildlife.

- 💇 - Idea 2

Create Eco-themed Public Sculptures

Create installations from recycled or sustainable materials, showcasing waste reduction while beautifying public spaces. Use this space to educate viewers on local environmental issues and inspire sustainable habits. For example, sculptures made from ocean plastic can highlight pollution and ocean health motivating others to recycle plastic.
