

Eco-Friendly Heritage Murals & Restoration Art

Use murals and street art as tools to revitalize and preserve cultural heritage and historic buildings. Employ eco-friendly, nontoxic paints to ensure environmental safety and prevent damage to old structures. Focus on themes that highlight the history, traditions, or cultural significance of the site, celebrating local stories and craftsmanship. This approach not only beautifies neglected areas but also raises awareness of cultural preservation and environmental stewardship.



Cultural Heritage Eco-Sculptures

Design public sculptures that celebrate heritage while cultural promoting sustainability. Use recycled or locally sourced sustainable materials to create art installations that honour the traditions, stories, or history of the area. These sculptures can also serve as educational tools, highlighting the importance of heritage preservation alongside environmental responsibility. For example, a sculpture made from reclaimed materials could represent a traditional craft or local icon, inspiring viewers to connect with cultural roots while adopting eco-conscious practices.

Historypin: A collaborative tool connecting communities with local history. For gathering and sharing historical photos, videos, and stories pinned to specific locations. Community members can contribute images and stories related to heritage sites, making it a valuable tool for preserving local heritage visually and interactively. https://www.historypin.org/en/



Artsteps is a platform that enables eco-health tourism entrepreneurs to create virtual exhibits or galleries showcasing cultural artefacts, historical images, or local artwork.
